Title: "Prostate Cancer Intervention Versus Observation Trial (PIVOT): A Randomized Trial Comparing Radical Prostatectomy versus Palliative Expectant Management for the Treatment of Clinically Localized Cancer" (VA – Cooperative Study #407)

Overall Goal: to find out whether treatment of prostate cancer by surgery to remove the prostate (called radical prostatectomy) is better than closely watching, waiting, and treating symptoms if the cancer progresses. The study endpoint is overall survival.
